TERMS OF AGREEMENT

Payment and Modification Policy

Registration payment reserves space for the camper(s) listed above. All payments are non-refundable. Payment for a week secures enrollment for the entire week, even if the camper(s) does not attend all days.

If payments are not received by the due date, the camper(s) will not be permitted to attend camp. Weekly payments are due 10 days prior to the start of the camp week (Friday). Failure to make payment on any due date—whether in person or due to a declined credit card—will result in cancellation of the participant's registration.

If a payment (credit card or check) is declined on the due date, a \$15 declined payment fee will be assessed.

Due to limited space, changes to selected camp weeks are not guaranteed. The camp schedule is subject to change based on circumstances beyond our control.

If a camper is unable to attend due to physical reasons (e.g., a broken leg), a doctor's medical note must be provided for payments to be applied toward future camps or Taekwondo memberships.

Additional fees:

- \$25 service fee for bounced checks
- \$25 service fee for modification of camp weeks (does not apply to adding weeks in advance)
- \$8 per additional hour for pickup after 4:30 p.m.

Failure to make required payments may result in referral to a collection agency.

Waiver and Release of Liability

I, as the legal guardian of the child(ren) listed above, acknowledge that participation in martial arts and fitness activities involves strenuous physical activity and carries inherent risks of injury and/or illness. I affirm that I have taken all reasonable steps to ensure that my child(ren) is/are in good health and physically capable of participating in the programs offered by UMS Martial Arts.

I understand and agree that participation in all programs, use of equipment or facilities (on or off premises), and participation in field trips shall be at our own risk. I acknowledge that children with food allergies must bring their own lunch and snacks.

I authorize the officers and personnel of UMS Martial Arts to transport my child(ren) as necessary. In the event of a medical emergency, I authorize UMS Martial Arts and its personnel to seek medical treatment for my child(ren), including emergency treatment deemed necessary by the attending physician.

I hereby release, indemnify, and hold harmless UMS Martial Arts, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, liabilities, or expenses (including attorney's fees) arising directly or indirectly from participation in UMS Martial Arts programs, use of facilities, transportation, or presence on or off premises.

I understand that UMS Martial Arts assumes no responsibility for injuries or illnesses resulting from my child's physical condition or participation in athletic activities, sports programs, transportation, or field trips (including but not limited to pools, movie theaters, embassies, Chuck E. Cheese, etc.). I assume all risks associated with participation and waive any claims for injury, illness, death, or property damage.

UMS Martial Arts is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.

Transportation & Medical Authorization

I grant permission for my child to be transported by UMS Martial Arts for camp activities. Advance notice will be provided prior to outings whenever possible.

In the event of a medical emergency, every effort will be made to contact me or my designated emergency contact. If neither can be reached, I authorize UMS Martial Arts to secure necessary medical treatment, including hospitalization.

Camp Enrollment Minimum

Camp sessions will be canceled if enrollment is four (4) students or fewer.

Loss, Damage, or Theft of Property

I understand and agree that UMS Martial Arts and its personnel are not responsible for personal property that is lost, damaged, or stolen on or off premises or during field trips.

Photography Release

I authorize UMS Martial Arts to photograph or record me or my child(ren) and to use such images for promotional or marketing purposes. I understand that no compensation will be provided for such use.
